The children and young people from the Sacred Valley with disabilities do not have any educational or health resources available. Most of them are marginalized by their own families and communities who do not have the necessary knowledge or resources to deal with the situation.

- I am a loving child and I like to be on the playground.

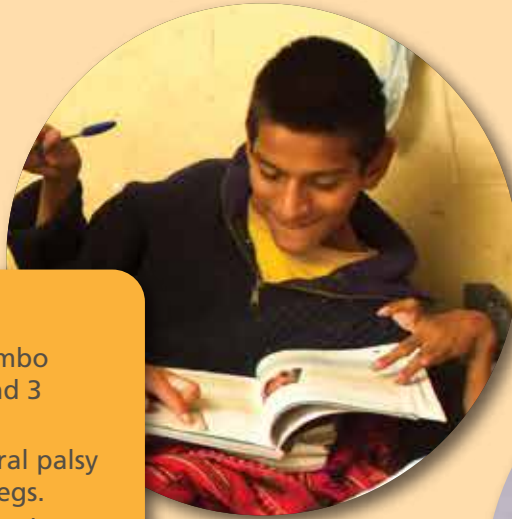


## My name is Marina
