Visiting options during the school term

FULL DAY

VISIT TO OUR INTERCULTURAL SCHOOL

SCHEDULE:

from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm (6-7 hours approximately)

Guests can experience a guided tour to our Sol y Luna School, located just 200 meters from the hotel. On the visit we explain the thinking behind it and convey how we can all support and contribute to this very special project.

INCLUDE:

A souvenir certificate of your valuable contribution, with official recognition from the Peruvian government is included. There is also an option to buy yourself a lunch and accompany the schoolchildren during their lunch hour.

ITINERARY

09:00 am.

Introducing our project

Take a tour of the primary, secondary and special education premises (Paqari project) then see a presentation from the Sol y Luna Association, describing its objectives, history and current projects. It gives a fascinating insight into how the Sol y Luna School works, how it is managed and financed.

10:00 am. to 10:40 am.

Sharing time

It's playtime! While the children take a break, it gives us the perfect opportunity to mingle with them as they enjoy their games and activities for a duration of 30 - 40 minutes.

10:40 am. to 12:30 am.

Experience in the classroom

The children then go back into their lessons. Activities take place within the classrooms or the therapy rooms of the "Paqari" center (we recommend a max of 2 visitors per classroom). The visit will be tailored according to the curriculum and the profile of the visitors, to achieve the best experience for both parties.



Lunch

A break for lunch is programmed. Visitors who wish to participate in the school lunch may do so as an optional extra.

13:30 pm. to 15:00 pm.

Afternoon classes

We continue with the classroom experience into the afternoon hours when the more enjoyable, dynamic and motivating work activities are scheduled until the end of the school day when the children depart the school and head home.

ALTERNATIVE EXTRA:

In the afternoon we can arrange an additional visit to a local family - this insider experience allows you to learn how people live by being invited into their homes.

Another alternative is to visit a foster home, a key part of our educational program as theses families support children who live in the most remote communities, providing a temporary home during the week so they can be close to the school. All these experiences are important to understand the lives of the Sol y Luna children.

AFTERNOON

SCHEDULE:

from 2:00 pm to 5:30 pm (approximately 3 hours)

There is no minimum number of visitors

You will be given a certificate with a formal acknowledgment of your contribution.

PROGRAM

02:00 pm.

Presentation of the project

Get to know the Sol y Luna Association with a tour of the facilities covering all levels from primary through secondary and special needs (our Paqari Project). You will learn about the goals of our association, how it came about and its ongoing projects; as well as how the school is run, managed

and financed. There is also a chance to visit a classroom and sit in on the last lesson of the day, or take part in the Special Education project in the Paqari Centre (we recommend just 2 visitors per classroom). Visits are arranged in the best possible way to suit the daily curriculum and profile of visitors.

Children at home

You will have the opportunity to visit a local family to see how and where the children stay during the week - these arrangements are for children who live in the most remote parts of the Sacred Valley, providing accommodation during the week so they can attend the school. Saying farewell.
