

VALLE SAGRADO - PERÚ -

HORSEBACK RIDING / FULL DAY
In the Sacred Valley

Known for their docile nature, Peruvian Paso horses offer a comfortable, relaxed way to explore this ancient Land of the Incas.

We leave the stables to ride through Rumichaca Baja, a community where we can observe daily life in the Sacred Valley, passing the maize fields and the Urubamba River

From here, the circuit continues towards the gorge of Media Luna, a simple settlement of farmers and their families on the site of abandoned Incan terraces. When we reach the irrigation reservoirs, behold the captivating Valley panoramas. We ride through Chajwar then ascend to Pumahuanca, another gorge that acts as a natural protection zone for native flora. You will see why this is the perfect place to rest and have lunch.

Next we descend towards Torrechayoq and continue to the site of Chichubamba. Our return route crosses the villages like Larespampa and Palcaraqui until we reach Sol y Luna.

The route may be modified depending on the conditions of the roads, or the interests of our riders. We could stay shorter or longer at certain stops and skip certain places in favor of others, as requested.

Equipment	Peruvian Hat or equestrian helmet, Saddle bags will be provided
Suggested Attire	Long trousers and sun protection.
Restrictions	No children under 7 years old; maximum weight 220 lbs/rider
Difficulty level	Intermediate, some experience required
