To introduce our guests to this homegrown art form traditionally pursued by women, Sol y Luna invites some of our favorite local weavers to demonstrate this knotty process. Watch as these talented experts untangle the natural wool fibers, then spin and color the threads with natural dyes made from the wealth of the Sacred Valley, namely flowers, roots and herbs, according to ancestral techniques. Though many of us are familiar with Andean textiles as a finished product, this appreciation only deepens to witness the mastery with which this ancient art is practiced.
